

Bangkok Airways signs Codeshare Agreement with Jet Airways (India)



Bangkok / 24 April 2015 – Bangkok Airways, a Thailand-based regional airline and Jet Airways, India's premier international airline, have entered into a codeshare agreement.

Under this reciprocal codeshare arrangement, Bangkok Airways will place its marketing code on Jet Airways' operations between Bangkok (BKK) and Mumbai (BOM). Likewise, Jet Airways will place its marketing code on Bangkok Airways' flights between Mumbai (BOM) and Bangkok (BKK).

The codeshare will reinforce the international global network of both airlines and provide more choice for customers between Thailand and India, with seamless and convenient connections. The codeshare flights will be open for sale on April 30, 2015 and travel effective May 4, 2015.
